The SE5 Forum Board

The SE5 Forum is coordinated by a Board of up to 18 members. We need Camberwell people to volunteer for the SE5 Forum Board to make the Forum as effective and as representative of all parts of Camberwell as possible. Why not volunteer yourself or propose someone who you know would be a good representative of your part of Camberwell or your Camberwell organisation? You can get more involved in your area, develop skills and make a contribution to Camberwell. It's interesting and fun.

What's involved?

We need people who can attend the Board's meetings in 2018-2019 and actively participate in shaping the Board's discussions and directing the Forum's work. Board meetings are usually held on the first Wednesday of every month (except August), 11 times per year. Board members also participate in one or more of the Forum's projects in its priority areas of Business, Transport and Identity in Camberwell.

How do I express interest?

Potential board members need to be proposed and seconded. The 2018–2019 Board members will be elected at the SE5 Forum's 2018 **Annual General Meeting (AGM)**, which will be held on **Wednesday 19th September, 6.30-8.30pm, in Room 3, Camberwell Library, Camberwell Green, London SE5 7AL.**

If you would like to become a member of the board or propose another member, please email your nomination to admin@se5forum.org.uk, stating the name and contact details of the potential board member, the person proposing and the person seconding the nomination. Please briefly say why you would like to join the Board and what skills, experience or areas of interest you would bring. Please note, you can either propose or second your own nomination, but not both.

Nominations should be sent no later than 7pm on 4 September 2018.

It is always helpful for those nominated to attend the AGM on 19 September, 6.30-8.30pm, at Camberwell Library, to meet the other membership of the Forum on the night.
